Course Description					
<p>In order to reduce the speed in the steep section, we set the gate that leads to the first jump of the steep section, lower. We brought more snow on the previous thin layer where the turn is before the big kicker, used snow cement yesterday and got it pretty hard. The big kicker in the middle of the steep was worked on: took away some kick and made it flatter. The blue gate after big kicker was moved to skier's right in order to reduce speed of about 1,80m. So we did with the next red gate 1,80m to skier's right. up hill short landing.) We filled the gap a little of the following jump (first of lower flat section). We moved the following red gate (before the double) to skier's right in order to reduce speed. We brought a little bit of snow on the last roller before last jump in order to be able to absorb it a little better. We added a gate before last jump for direction.</p>
